This week the children have been using language to describe positions and demonstrating their understanding using small world characters. They have been sequencing stories and retelling them using puppets.

This week's learning focus:

- The children listened to the story 'We're going on a bear hunt' and wrote a letter to the bear asking to be his friend.
- We learnt how animals manage to stay warm during the cold months.
- The first speed sounds from Read, Write, Inc have been taught. The children will continue to learn new sounds but less frequently as the emphasis now is to use the sounds to blend and read words.
- The children made caves in the 'creation station' for their very own bears.
