We have been busy this week rehearsing songs with Key Stage 1 for our Christmas performance. There's a real buzz in the air as the children get more and more excited at the prospect of Christmas!

This week's learning focus:

- The children have used the Numicon maths resource to help them order and count, we have been focusing on taking our time to be careful counters.
- In Read, Write, Inc we have been reading 'tricky red words' **I**, **you**, **said**, **come**, and **the**. It's important that the children understand that 'tricky words' cannot be sounded out, they just have to know them by sight!
