This week the children have been using language to describe positions and demonstrating their understanding using small world characters.

This week's learning focus:

- The children listened to the story 'We're going on a bear hunt' and wrote a letter to the bear.
- We have been playing an interactive game called 'Real Word or Fake Word', there are many games similar on the Letters and Sounds website.
- The first speed sounds from Read, Write, Inc have been taught. The children will continue to learn new sounds but less frequently as the emphasis now is to use the sounds to blend and read words.
