We told our adapted tales to each other using puppets, then we learnt about adjectives by playing games like 'Who am I?'

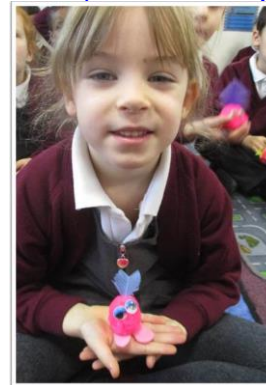


Reflecting on our learning this term, we have explored houses past and present. Our classroom calendar will show us more about this throughout December, it's a Victorian Christmas!
