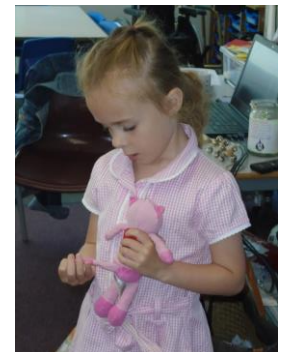
Children have started planning their next story about a naughty toy who visits our classroom and causes havoc.
