Our Learning Journey

In phonics, we have been learning the sounds: ai, ee and igh. Children are given opportunities to write on their whiteboards and time outdoors to write words and sentences in chalk.



In maths, we have been using a lot of comparison language: more than, less than, greater than. We have introduced the symbols used for greater than and less than by making a "crocodile" device to help them remember.



We have started "paired reading" in class each afternoon if possible. The children are benefitting from this quiet time with a peer and we are encouraging a lot of positive feedback and guidance to help us all improve our reading skills. Please can we have all reading record books in each day. Thank you.



In PE, our dance is coming along well with an introduction, middle and end.

Focus on Learning

Our phonic lessons this week will focus on oo, ar, or. The tricky words are: no and go.

In Maths, we will be looking at simple addition and subtraction. Children will be supported initially with many different manipulatives.

In science, we will be observing the change of season and going on another nature walk. We will be using our senses to record what we can hear, see, smell and feel.
