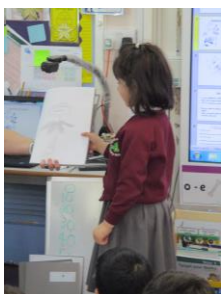
## Our Learning Journey
