We have had a good focus on phonics this week and cross curricular activities in Geography and computing. The children have used their laptops to search for hot and cold places on Googlemaps. We have "flown" to Paris and seen the Eiffel Tower, we then went to Niagra Falls in Canada and we discussed what hot and cold places look like on the satellite images. Children are being introduced to key vocabulary in computing such as: desktop, taskbar, maximize, search engine and hyperlink.
