Our Learning Journey

Children have done numerous activities based on our book *The Tiger Who Came to Tea* such as writing a recount of the story, writing a list of all the food the Tiger ate and drawing a cartoon tiger in art using the elements of shape and line.

During maths, we have been measuring all sorts of objects with cubes and we have moved onto halves and doubles as well as repeated addition. In geography last week, we studied various paintings by famous artists, which has inspired us to create another collage portraying the weather by using the sponging technique to create texture and mood.

In RE the children sampled hot cross buns and some chocolate eggs. Children have been encouraged to retell the Easter Story and consider why specific symbols are used over Easter and they have made some delicious Easter nests in our school kitchen.



Focus on Learning

In phonics, children are being introduced to many other tricky words like: because, many, once, friend and different. Children will also be looking at different pronunciation of the "ch" and "ou" sounds.

In English, we will be thinking about who we will invite to our tea party and how to write an invitation. During maths, we will be exploring coins and engaging in many hands on activities.
