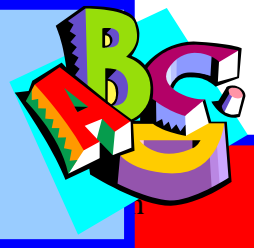

Our Learning Journey

In phonics, we have been learning the sounds "ear" and "air". We have visited the library again this week and we are still doing our paired reading as often as possible. I am very pleased to report that children are enjoying these activities and they are keen to read as often as possible.

In maths, we are continually practising our counting skills and we have managed to order ourselves as a whole class from 0 to 30 in 50 seconds!

Please can your child write the journal entry as this encourages writing skills and enables them to read their entry back to the class at the end of the day.

During maths next week, we will be practising our counting skills and finding pairs to 5, 6, 7 and 10. We will introduce the numberline to help us with addition and subtraction problems.
