Our Learning Journey

We have had an amazing start to our Spring Term with a vast amount of science and history activities taking place. We have planted tulips, hebe, cyclamen, ivy and heather in our outdoor space. The children have been looking at the different parts of the plants using a magnifying glass. They have sketched a diagram of a plant and labelled it correctly.

Children have been discussing what the terms "evergreen" and "deciduous" mean and we have looked at many information books to help with our understanding of these scientific words.



In history, we have worked together to help us order significant events in the world that took place centuries ago. We then focussed our attention on the 1960's when the Beatles released their first album, the first heart transplant took place and 50 p coins were introduced.

Children have watched footage of the Beatles, the first landing on the moon in 1969 and they have seen a video of Muhammad Ali boxing in 1960. Finally, we looked at some old toys that were released in the 60's and completed a sorting activity.

Focus on Learning

We will begin Phase 5 of our phonics programme and we will continue to practise our handwriting. In maths, we are going to look at money. This will lead onto repeated addition and subtraction up to 50.

We will be working scientifically again this week by carrying out an absorbency experiment and we will continue to observe the weather.
