Our Learning Journey

We have had a busy week in Year 1 as we have started our music lessons, RE, PE and ipad maths. Children are following our class rules really well and they have been working as a team to adhere to the Class Promise.

Our daily phonics routine has seen us revisit sounds like: j / v / w and x. We have done actions and they have written their sounds beautifully on the whiteboards. Our handwriting lessons have also started with the letter "s".



In Maths we have been counting and sorting various objects. We are looking specifically at numbers only up to 20 and have been asking various questions:

- What does sorting mean?
- How have you sorted your objects?
- Which group is bigger?

In RE, we have looked at various signs and symbols to brainstorm ideas of what those images are telling us. We have drawn word maps to describe a special person in our lives.

Focus on Learning

Our phonic lessons this week will focus on y, z and qu. The tricky words are he, she, the and to.

We will continue to revisit all the sounds taught in Chestnut Class but the main focus is on the skill of segmenting and blending. In English, we will start reading "The Three Little Pigs" so that we can link it to our Science learning which is about different materials.

In Maths, we will continue to use many manipulatives to help us count up to 20. We will be revisiting how to correctly write numerals to 20 and introduce place value language like: tens and ones.

Our theme this term is "Homes". I'd be really grateful if you could send in a photograph of the outside of your child's home, for a display in our classroom. Please mark the back of your photograph with your child's name.
