## Our Learning Journey

This week, we have started to look at different explorers in History. We have learned about Sir Ranulph Fiennes and Amy Johnson. The children have spoken at length about the qualities these two people must have possessed in order to dream, plan and accomplish their goals.

## Focus on Learning

During phonics, we will look at alternative spellings for "ai" and "c" sounds. Examples are: snail, cake, lady. For "c" the examples are: cat, lick and school. Our tricky words are still: many, laughed, because, different, any, eyes, friends, once, please.

In History, we will be learning about Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. In maths we are dividing numbers by sharing them out equally into groups. For RE, children will be discussing Spring and new beginnings. We will look at various symbols and how they relate to Easter. We are planning to bake some hot cross buns over the next few weeks.
