Our Learning Journey

This week has been busy as we have completed our Phonics Screening Check and we have had class photographs and plenty of Assembly practise.

Children have spent time working on fractions and have begun to find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ in quantities and shape. They are learning that a half is one of two equal parts and they are practising how to write $\frac{1}{2}$ as a fraction.

Children have also used Venn diagrams to sort animal into herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. They have enjoyed another session of swimming and continue to use laptops so that they can practise their keyboard skills and find different places of interest.
