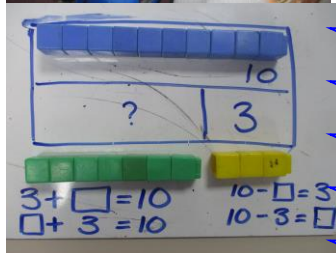
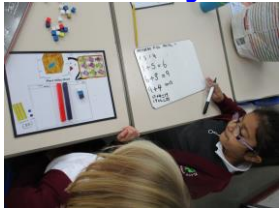

## Our Learning Journey

In phonics, we have been learning the sounds "ure" and "er". We will continue to revisit sounds like: "or"; "ur"; "ear"; "ure"; "oi" and "air" throughout the rest of the term as these are proving to be a little tricky.

In maths, we are continually practising our counting skills but we are now heavily focussed on place value and using the correct vocabulary. We are talking about tens and ones, identifying which digit is in the tens column and which is in the ones column. We are also discovering the value of the digit in each column.



On Thursday, we welcomed our parents in for a learning session on e-safety, phonics and maths. Thank you all for attending. I am very pleased with the parental support shown and I was so proud of the children's learning behaviour.

We have been rehearsing for the nativity production which will take place in December and we have been looking at artwork by Kandinsky. This artist used a lot of shapes and lines to produce abstract art and we hope to create our own artwork for the cloakroom over the next couple of weeks.

## Focus on Learning

During maths next week, we will be finding pairs to 5, 6, 7 and 10 using the bar model. We will also introduce the numberline to help us with addition and subtraction problems.

In art, we will start planning our abstract piece by giving thought to the shapes we will use and the different types of lines.

We will finish our Hansel and Gretel story telling activities and start to decorate the witch's house with gingerbread men. This will lead nicely into our next story "The Gingerbread Man". Thank you all for your support and positive feedback received on Thursday.
