Our Learning Journey

In science, we have been learning about the human body. Children have played many games in which they identified various parts of their bodies and we have watched a few video clips. Children were confident with the basic body parts so I included more specific vocabulary such as: thighs, waist, shin and nostril rather than merely expecting children to label leg, body and nose.

Children have enjoyed some multi-skill sessions and we have seen an improvement in their bat and ball skills already.



In history, we have a display of various events that took place in the 1960's but it would be nice to have photo's of the children as babies to include in our timeline display. Please send photo's in as soon as possible, if you can. We also completed our drawings of plants using chalk to add colour. The aim of the lesson was to encourage children to mix primary colours to create secondary colours therefore, they were only given red, yellow and blue chalk but the flowers and vase were orange, green and purple.

Focus on Learning

We will identify the five vowels, look at sentence structure and start phase 5 tricky words. These will be pasted in the back of reading record books for children to practise.

We will be working scientifically again this week by carrying out two investigations on smell and taste.
