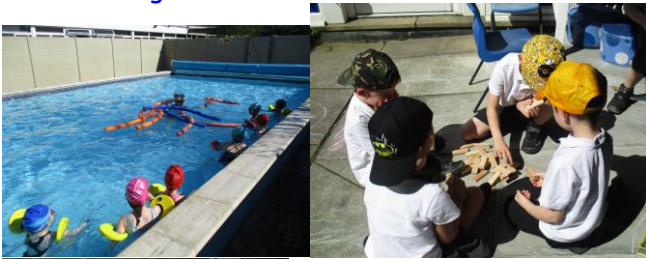

Our Learning Journey

We have started our Summer term with gorgeous weather, outdoor phonics fun and swimming!! Children have settled quickly and we have had a focus on several phonics activities by getting the children active and using equipment like hoops and beanbags to aid their segmenting and blending skills when reading.



The children's artwork from Spring term is on display in our library - they drew animals in pencil using their knowledge of shape and coloured them with watercolour paints. Please do pop in to see their exhibition if you have a spare moment.



Focus on Learning

In English, we will be looking at several nursery rhymes to help us with our phonics. We will analyse and discuss the rhymes in depth and recite them. I am sure you will hear some wonderful rhymes over the next few weeks.

In maths, we are revisiting place value by looking at two digit numbers and asking children how many tens and ones are in a given number. We are also going to compare and order numbers. In computing, we will be looking at the internet and how we can find information safely. Children will start to use our school laptops and we will link this learning with our history topic.

During science, children will be sorting living and non-living things and they will continue to investigate our class tadpoles using a magnifying glass.
