Our Learning Journey

This week, there has been a focus on Careers so I decided to spend full days working with the children on ipads so that they could explore "coding". I am sure that you will agree, technology is evolving at a rapid pace and I am certain that many of the children will be in careers that we haven't heard of yet. There certainly weren't web developers when I was a child!

The children have used the ipads to programme BeeBots to move around a certain path. We have used a lot of positional language too such as: forwards, backwards, left turn, right turn.

Then they used a programme called Espresso Coding. They can now log on independently and create their own code for various characters to move across the screen. They can change the background and they can add text independently.



Finally, we have introduced our class to an amazing programme called SeeSaw where they can create a digital profile of all their learning.
