## Our Learning Journey



In phonics, we have been learning y, z and qu. We have had plenty of time outdoors to use the large chalk on the patio, the pens for our letters on the whiteboard and we have written in glitter.

We have seen fabulous learning from the children as they have managed to orally construct their own sentences about The Three Little Pigs before writing a perfect sentence themselves.

In maths, we have timed ourselves to see if we can order our numbers 0 to 28. This involves a lot of teamwork and communication from all pupils. At the moment, their time to complete is 1 minute 50 seconds!

Our dance classes have begun this week and the children are exploring various ways of moving in different directions. Their first dance is based on our theme this term "houses and construction".

## Focus on Learning

Our phonic lessons this week will focus on sh, ch, ng and th. The tricky words are: we, me and be.

We will continue to revisit all the sounds taught in Chestnut Class but the main focus is on the skill of segmenting and blending. In English, we will continue to analyse the story of "The Three Little Pigs" so that we can engage in more role play activities and writing.

In Maths, we will continue to use many manipulatives to help us count and compare numbers up to 20. We will be revisiting how to correctly write numerals to 20 and make piles of objects to compare amounts.

Our School Council will be holding elections next week and many children in Year 1 have put their names forward.
