## Our Learning Journey

This week, children have been sharing amounts into equal groups. We are using vocabulary such as: groups / lots of / sharing / dividing / arrays. Children have been using arrays to circle 3 groups of 2 or 2 groups of 10.

In English, we have designed an invitation for our 50<sup>th</sup> tea party and we will begin to write instructions on how to make a simple jam sandwich. This will coincide with our RE lesson as they will need to write instructions on how to make easter nests! Fingers crossed!

We have also been learning about Christopher Columbus and his voyage across the Atlantic. This will be given as discussion home learning again.



In RE, we have been looking at various symbols that we see over the Easter period such as the cross on hot cross buns. Eggs are also a significant symbol of new life and resurrection.

## Focus on Learning

During phonics, we are moving on to the alternative spellings of writing a sound. For instance "ai" - can be written as: a\_e; ai; ay or a.

In History, we will be learning about Neil Armstrong and then we will be moving onto animals in science as we have an exciting visit on the 7<sup>th</sup> May 2019 planned for the children.

In maths, we will be looking at mass. This will link in nicely to our baking activities for RE. Children will be investigating objects that are heavier or lighter than other objects.
