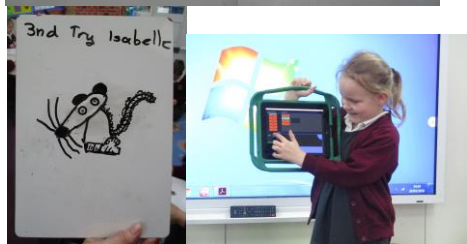
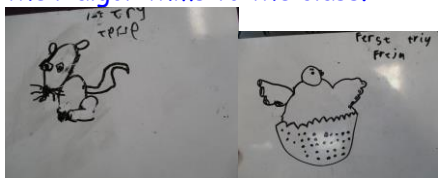

Our Learning Journey

We have drawn numerous animals using our knowledge of shape and we have used our art vocabulary like: portrait / landscape / hatching / shading / texture. These drawings are linked to our Science learning about the different classifications of animals. So far we have drawn mammals such as tigers and mice.
