## Our Learning Journey

In English, we learned about captions. We wrote our own captions for some illustrations from books we have enjoyed so far this year.

The children are always keen to read so we have responded to this by giving them more opportunities to read with a friend in class. This is recorded as "paired reading" in the reading record books and I am so pleased to see how they have progressed.

During maths, we returned to our shape unit and completed our leaf symmetry activity. Children created leaves from folded paper and coloured them in autumn colours.

We are still talking about tens and ones, identifying which digit is in the tens column and which is in the ones column. We are also discovering the value of the digit in each column using games.



We continue to rehearse for the nativity which takes place on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018. I am also very pleased to see that their handwriting is coming along really well too.

## Focus on Learning

We will begin our next book "The Gingerbread Man" which will encourage children to engage in role-play, design gingerbread men and bake gingerbread in our school kitchen. This unit will take place over a couple of weeks as we need to fit things around the nativity rehearsals.

Please do let me know if your child has allergies to eggs, flour, ginger or sugar as they will be making the dough from raw ingredients, rolling, shaping and baking. Very exciting in Year 1!
