Children have settled back into school well after the Easter break and I can't believe how they have grown in just 2 weeks. This was a great opportunity for us to complete some PSHE lessons so we spent time talking about how we change and grow throughout our lives. We have talked about how we can keep ourselves healthy and what we need in order to grow.

During maths, we have returned to simple counting games up to 100 using many objects in the classroom. We have spoken a lot about one more than and one less than. We have looked at our symbols +, - and = again and used our knowledge of these symbols to complete missing information.

The children have also been introduced to volume/capacity and they have spent some wonderful time outdoors with water and measuring jugs.

Children have also started auditioning for our Year 1 Assembly "Hansel and Gretel". We are planning our performance together and we have also been listening to the songs this week so that we can start learning them.

Focus on Learning

During phonics, we will be looking at texts together and identifying the different sounds. We are thinking of all the different ways we can write the same sound. For instance "ie" can also be written as "igh" "i_e" "eye" "i" and "y".

Next week is a short week so we will focus mainly on Science so that we are prepared for our UKZooLab visit on the 7th May 2019.
