We have spent a lot of time on our Hansel and Gretel story. The children have written excellent lists of the types of sweets that may be found on the house. We have linked this story with the value of TRUST and we have discussed whether the witch was trustworthy. The children have also written a recount of the story using sequential words such as: then, next, after that. In maths, we have been learning about the days of the week and we have been building the witch's house out of 3D shapes.



We have observed evergreen and deciduous trees in our school grounds and will keep a record of how they change over the year.
