We have had an amazing week: labelling our bodies, painting Mr Fuller's body outline for a wall display, colour mixing and drawing plants, taste and smell investigations as well as our wonderful trip to Wisley. Children were learning about how plants grow, what plants need in order to survive and what parts of the plants can be eaten.

Focus on Learning

We are well underway with our Phase 5 sounds. So far we have learnt the graphemes: oy, ie, ou, ir. Our tricky words are: Mr, Mrs, people, oh, their. We are also looking at how to write capital letters.

In maths next week, we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes, halving them and moving quickly onto halving different images and numbers.
