Our Learning Journey

In English, children first wrote instructions on how to wash their hands properly as this complements our hygiene knowledge when baking in the kitchen. Then they wrote instructions for making easter nests. We looked at using bossy (imperative) verbs in our instructions and children have excelled in presenting the recipe in an acceptable format.

We have also been learning about Christopher Columbus and his voyage across the Atlantic. This will be given as discussion home learning again.



In RE, we are still looking at various symbols that we see over the Easter period such as the cross on hot cross buns. Children have written instructions on how to make an Easter Garden, they have baked hot cross buns and made their easter nests.

Focus on Learning

During phonics, we are moving on to the alternative spellings of writing a sound.

In History, we will be learning about Neil Armstrong and then we will be moving onto animals in science as we have an exciting visit on the 7th May 2019 planned for the children. A letter has been placed in book bags.

In maths, we are still investigating weight. Children will be investigating objects that are heavier or lighter by comparing various items found in our classroom.
