This week in Maths we have been measuring length. We began by measuring ourselves using decimetres before moving on to measure smaller objects in centimetres. We have also been learning to solve word problems involving length.

In English, we read the story 'The Shopping Basket'. We acted the story out in groups and tried to recall the parts of the story in the correct order. We used the story to help us write lists and instructions.

In Science this week we have begun learning about the properties of different materials. We planned and carried out an investigation to see which type of paper was the most absorbent and would be best for mopping up spilt water. We found out that kitchen roll is very absorbent but newspaper is not.
