In English we took inspiration from 'The Diary of a Wombat' story that we have been reading to write recounts of other animals' days.

We linked our science to our 'Frozen' learning and carried out an investigation to see how we could melt Elsa's frozen hands. We made predictions before we started. Some of us thought that sawdust would melt Elsa's hands quickly because if it keeps rabbits and guinea pigs warm then it will warm her hands. We found out that the frozen hands covered in salt melted the fastest, which helps us to understand why salt is added to the roads during cold weather.
