Learning Journey

In English we have been reading the poem 'Aliens Stole My Underpants'. We learnt the poem off by heart and recited it in groups to the class. We used the poem to write our own funny alien poems; thinking of funny ways aliens could use everyday objects.



In maths we have been revising methods for solving addition and subtraction calculations. We have practised drawing our own number lines and then jumping in 10s and 1s either forwards or backwards to find the answers to questions.

In RE we have been thinking about celebrations. We learnt about how Muslims celebrate the birth of a new baby in the family. We compared traditions in Islam to celebrations we have had in our own families for special occasions.
