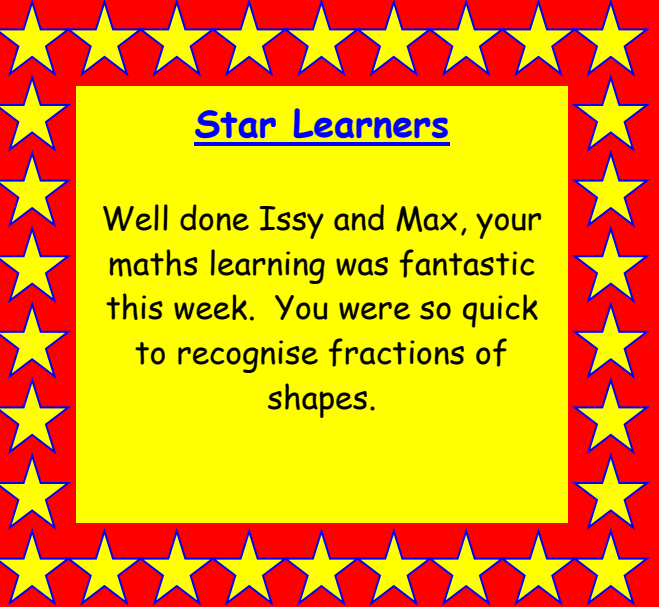

We found $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of numbers and then thought if we can find those fractions, how would we find $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{2}{3}$? We challenged ourselves to work it out!

Our PE learning this week moved on from static balances to dynamic balances. We had fun walking along a line with fluidity and minimal wobbling. We practised our skills on the apparatus as we followed a course of apparatus around the hall.
