Welcome back to school. The children have all returned keen and ready to learn.

In English we have started learning about quest stories. We read 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers and sequenced the events in the story. We also used the story to help us learn about the past and present tense.

Our Maths learning has been quite challenging this week as we have been learning to tell the time to quarter of an hour on analogue and digital clocks. We will keep practising! Next week we will be learning how to tell the time to 5 minutes and solving problems relating to time.

In Science we will be looked at a range of different types of seeds and what they might become. We learnt about how seeds move from one place to another and had a go at making our own spinning sycamore 'seeds' from paper. Next week we will be designing our own seeds.
