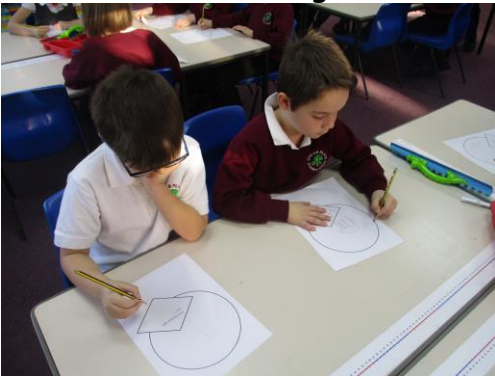

Learning Journey

In English this week we have been reading poems with repeating patterns. We have also had a go at writing our own poems about things we saw on the way to school and what we would put into a magic box. We tried to be imaginative so that the poems would be interesting to read.



In Maths we have begun learning how to multiply by 2, 5 and 10. We have looked for patterns when we count in steps of each number and used these to help us. We are also using 'Percy Parker' songs to help us learn our times tables.



We have read the Christmas story in RE and sequenced the main parts to help us retell the story.
