We have done a lot of learning with fractions and are beginning to explain the difference between unit and non unit fractions more consistently. We realise the need for knowing our tables. Please continue to support us at home too.

We have been using sub headings to sort key words in Non-Fiction texts and using them to write factual statements. We have also been reinforcing our knowledge of features used in this genre.

We used stick figures to create movement and were surprised at how this can be used in our sketching.
