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Our Learning Journey

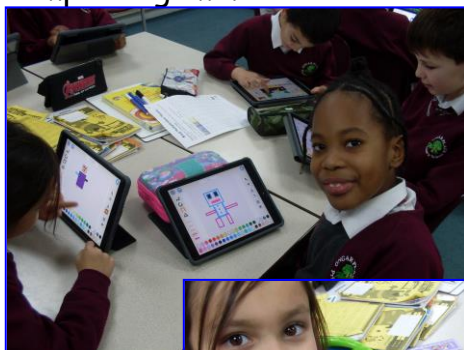
Welcome back to school -It was great to see everyone coming into school ready to learn.
