Our Learning Journey:

We have been learning to recognise and use parallel, perpendicular, horizontal, vertical and curved lines by creating a skyline and labelling them. We have also identified the different lines in 2D shapes.

We have all created our puppet patterns and begun to add mod roc to rod and string puppets. Some of us have begun to cut out the pattern for our glove puppets.
