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Our Learning Journey

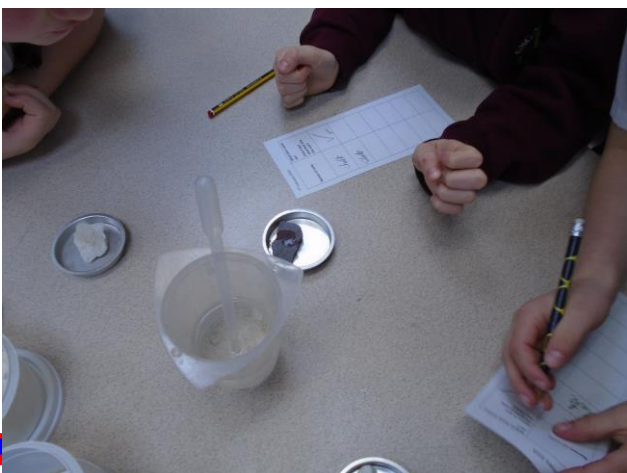
We enjoyed reading about the news story of, "My Granny is a Robber," and were able to match newspaper features within a planner. We have been learning to record quotes.
