Our Learning Journey

This week we have begun practising the songs for our carol concert. We are very excited to take part in this now that we are in KS2.

In English, we have continued our learning based on 'The Shirt machine'. We have used imperative verbs to write instructions and started to explore how we can use descriptive language to make explanation texts more interesting.

In Maths we have been exploring capacity. We have used millilitres and litres to measure and compared the capacity of different containers.

As an introduction to our DT project this term, we made moving figures from card joined together by split pins.



Focus on Learning

Next week we will be using the skills we have learnt to plan and write our own explanation texts.

In Maths we will be using number lines to compare and round numbers and to find differences.

We will also begin to plan a moving Christmas book. In our DT lessons, we will use levers and sliding mechanisms to help us make these books. Hopefully we will be able to read them to some of the children in KS1 at the end of term.
