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Our Learning Journey

We have investigated the strength of rocks by using a drop of water on a variety of sample rocks. We were learning to understand what permeable and impermeable means. We recorded the investigation with our results. We were able to conclude that the softer the rock the more the water travels through it.



We focussed on the story of Daniel and the Lions Den and learned how God rescued him. We enjoyed making a lion's head to help us remember this.

We have continued to use a modelling programme called Scratch and are able to use instructions of motion and sound to make a dog chase a cat.



Using our times table knowledge is developing and supporting us to calculate multiplication of $TU \times U$ and we are becoming more proficient at using partitioning and the grid method.
