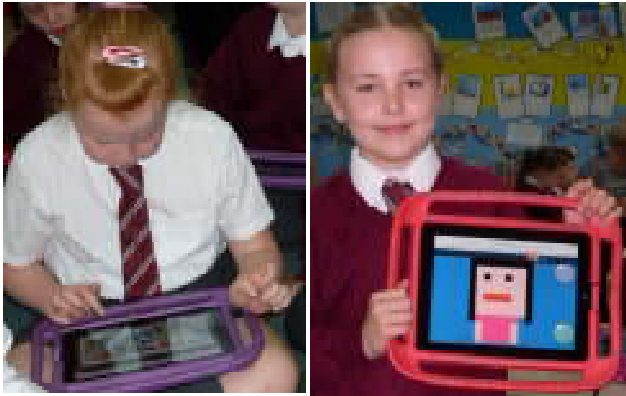


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Our Learning Journey

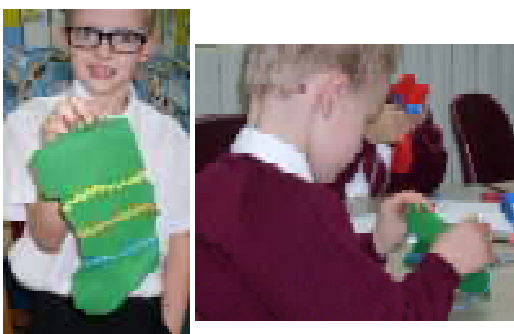
We enjoyed using a coding programme and were able to pop balloons and move them, using commands.
