We also enjoyed creating a scenario for why Humpty Dumpty fell off the wall. Some articles showed that he recovered and some reported his death – very sad news.

We learned about Skara Brae, a Stone Age village in Orkney and learned that they had stone beds and stone dressers where they might have laid out their jewellery. We made our own bracelet or necklace to help us remember this.
