Our Learning Journey

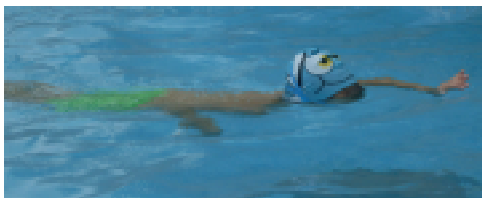
Well Done to Reece and Jessica B for becoming the new school councillors for Beech. They are looking forward to representing their class.
