This week has been another busy one in Year 3. We are continuing to practise the songs for the carol concert and are getting very excited about performing at the church in a couple of weeks.

On Tuesday John from the 'Children of the Dump' charity came to talk to us in assembly about children in the Philippines who need to scavenge on rubbish dumps because their families are so poor. We discussed this further in our RE lesson where we were thinking about the spirit of Christmas and how important it is to help others less fortunate than ourselves.

We began to plan our own Christmas story books this week. We started by looking at examples of Christmas stories and books with moving parts. We then experimented with card, tape and split pins and tried to make our own levers and mechanisms - this is not as easy as it sounds! Finally we planned out our own story, thinking about a beginning, middle and ending and considering how we would like the pictures to move. We are all set to start making our books next week.
