

Music

Play music with increasing control
Develop an understanding of musical composition
Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts
Use and understand musical notation

This term we will be further developing our ukulele playing skills with Mrs Meyer. We will be creating our own compositions.

RE

Why is prayer important to Christians? How do Christians prepare for Easter? What is Maundy Thursday?

Children will learn that there are different ways of praying. That Christians prepare for Easter in different ways. They will learn how Maundy Thursday connects with the Easter story.

Art

Learn about great artists in history
Develop techniques; drawing, painting and sculpture

Explore and produce creative work

The children will be exploring how conflicts are represented in art and planning and painting their own Viking invasion scene.

Year 4

History

Can place local and British historical events on a timeline

Develop a secure understanding of The Viking struggle for the Kingdoms of England

Children will learn how and why the Vikings invaded England. They will study the importance of being a warrior in Viking times and their way of life including clothing, trade and farming.

The children will also learn about why Viking long ships were a good mode of transport and how they were built. In a link with literacy they will also be learning about Viking sagas.

DT

Prepare and cook simple savoury dishes using a range of cooking techniques

Understand and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown and processed

Children will be investigating Viking recipes and making different types of bread using ingredients that the Vikings may have used. We will compare Viking and modern breads.

We will be revising important rules for food safety and hygiene as we work in DT.

Computing

Develop collaboration skills

Evaluate digital content

Evaluate and review own and other's work

Draw and construct tree diagrams to sort and classify objects

Learn how to use the internet safely, respectfully and responsibly

Children will analyse and discuss sport reports using examples from the internet. They will create their own sports news report which they will share and work on together online.

The children will also use algorithms to sort and identify objects and create tree diagrams.

Throughout all computing the importance of e-safety will be reinforced with the children.

Geography

Using maps, atlases and globes

World Geography

8 points of the compass

Children will find out where the Vikings came from and how they journeyed to the UK. We will also learn the reasons why Vikings moved to new settlements.

PE

To link skills to make actions and sequences of movement

To engage in collaborative physical activities

Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance

Perform dances using a range of movement patterns

The children will be developing dances linked to their Viking learning. They will work independently and collaboratively to create sequences of movements.

Children will develop their French vocabulary and learn how to build sentences linked to the classroom. They will be learning simple adjective agreements. They will learn to say the multiples of ten, up to 100. They will develop simple conversations about sport and healthy eating.
