In theme we are learning about the Vikings and on Tuesday we made some Viking oat biscuits.



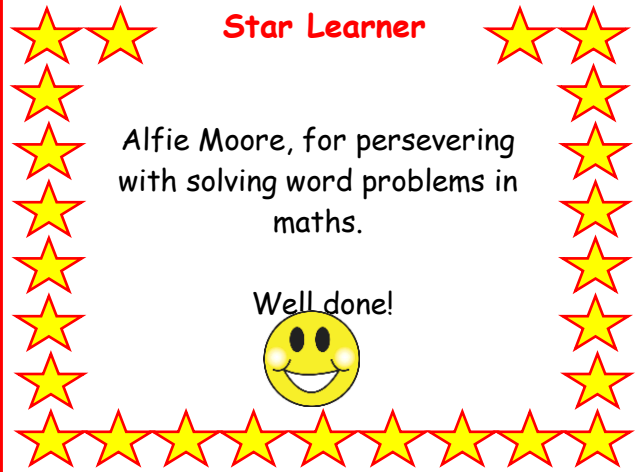
## Learning focus
