During PE we started to investigate balance.

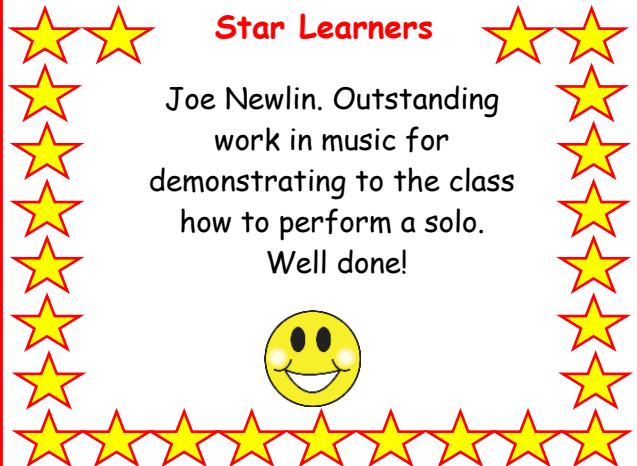


## Focus on Learning
