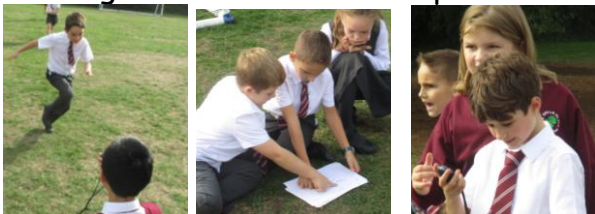
Our Learning Journey
