Our week has been busy and fun! We had a visitor who told us how important it is to be in school every day.



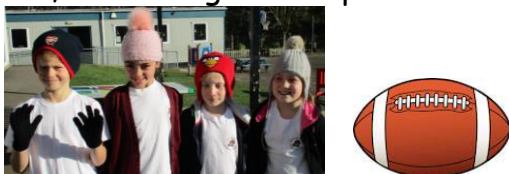
In science we have been learning about electricity and how an atom is made up of neutrons, protons and electrons.
