We wrote a narrative for a silent film 'The Piano' by Aidan Gibbons. We had to think of different emotions and used thesauruses to help us find some alternative words.

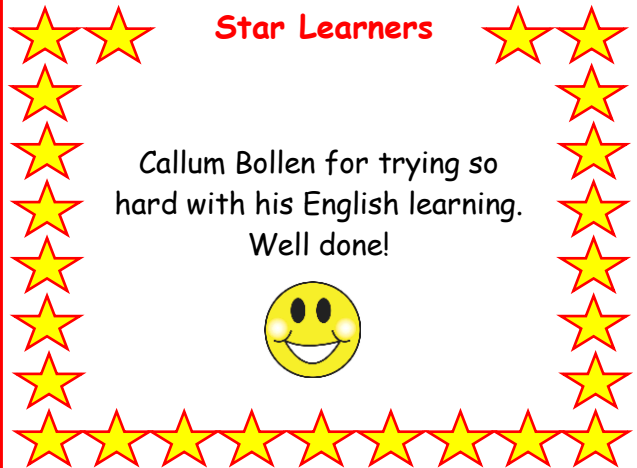
We are learning how to talk about healthy living in French, thinking about food and keeping active. Learning new vocabulary for food, drink and sports.
