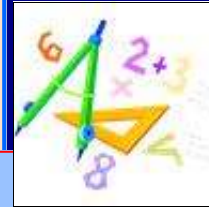

In English we have concentrated on speech in written texts. Firstly, we reviewed the use of inverted commas focusing on the use of commas. Later, we changed a prose text to a play-script. We used the features and added stage directions in the present tense. However, our big focus has been on performance!

Continuing with fractions we have been learning how to simplify or reduce fractions. Also we have been working on finding equivalent fractions.
