This Week...

We have started a new learning unit in English studying biography and autobiography. We have learned about and compared the features of each. We have also returned to the construction of complex sentences with main and subordinate clauses. Later in the week we have written our own short autobiographical recount. Next week, we will read some more about Roald Dahl and Michael Morpurgo and then write a fuller autobiography including features and complex sentences.

In Maths we have learned to add and subtract decimal numbers using number-lines and more formal column methods. We have also learned how to read and use Roman numerals as well as negative numbers. Next week, are going to start looking at multiplication and division beginning with factors and multiples.
